Preface

This directory was compiled through the amalgamation of four existing databases: a list of programs receiving funding from Ontario's Anti-Human Trafficking Strategy Community Supports Fund, the Federal Victim Services Directory, the Ontario Victim Services Database, and the Canadian Human Trafficking Hotline Referral Directory.

Duplicates, programs that are no longer active, and programs that did not focus on delivering services directly to people who have been or are being sex trafficked were excluded.

Our hope is that this resource is useful for those providing services and other supports to people who have been sex trafficked across Ontario/Canada, and for survivors themselves. We encourage you to use and share this directory to broaden professional networks within and across regions of Ontario/Canada to better serve people who have been sex trafficked.

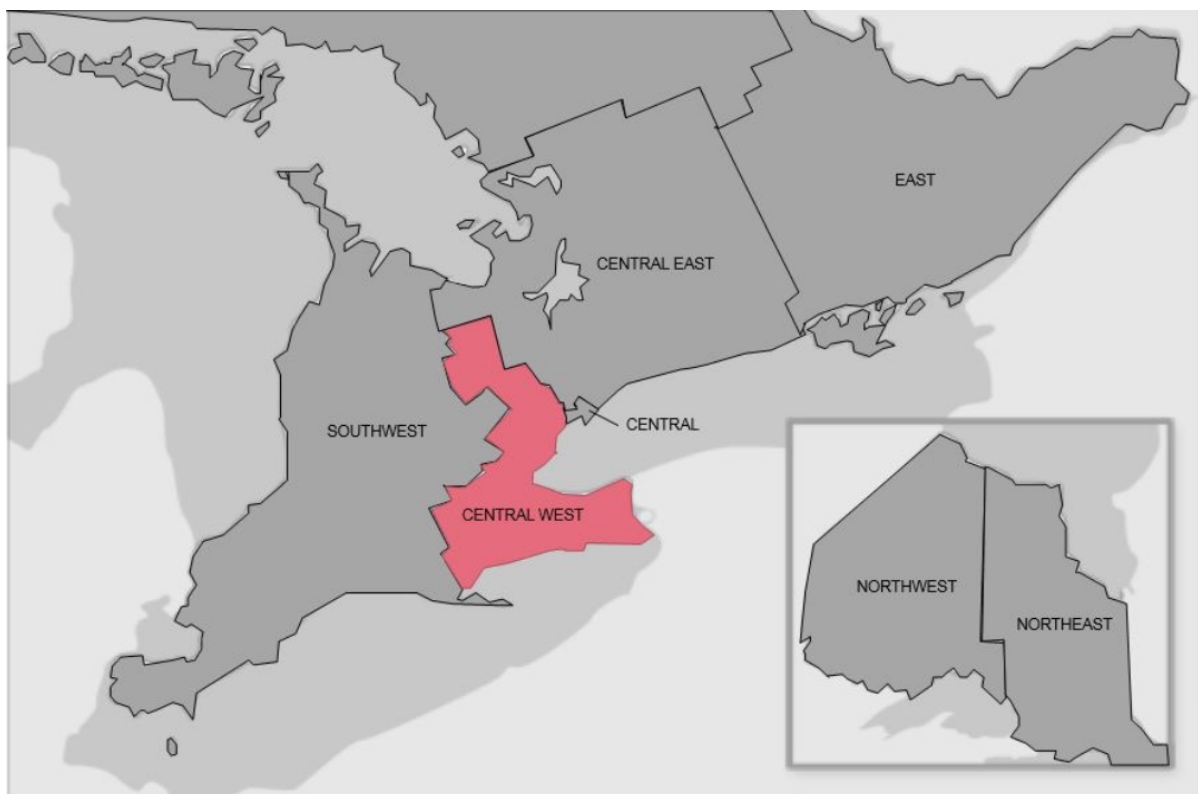
Native Child and Family Services of Toronto

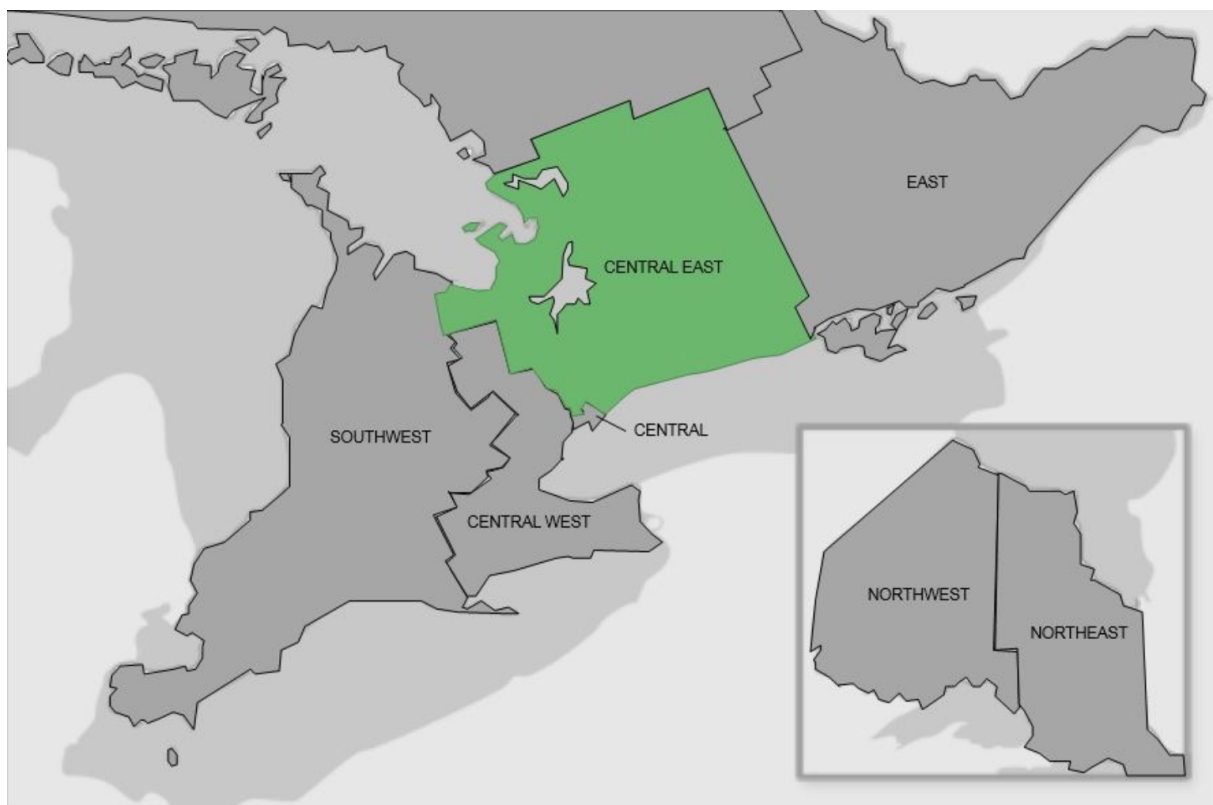

Survivors are not required to be enrolled in the residential services to acquire services. Drug and alcohol use is not permitted in the program, but those taking Methadone/Suboxone are accepted. Clients have access to medical services in both programs.
